(Marshfield, WI) – In 2020 Marshfield Utilities found elevated levels of lead in drinking water in some homes with lead services. This is a bi-annual notice to the public. Lead can cause serious health problems, especially for pregnant women and young children. Those who have a copper service or have had their service updated since 2020, have nothing to be concerned about.
